Steam locomotive 23 002 of the German Federal Railways. Epoch III.

Motor with flywheel. Drive on five axles. Two traction tyres. Digital Interface PluX16. Coupler pocket according to NEM 362 standards. Close coupler motion link between locomotive and tender.

Model equipped with integrated load sensing digital decoder and sound functions from factory.

- Version with round smoke stack
- Wheels with delicate spokes made of metal
- With hand painted silver boiler bands

"What if?" is a frequently-asked question posed by model builders. This is not surprising because that's how new creative ideas can flourish and be developed and contribute to innovative games. So what if the German Deutsche Bundesbahn had already acquired one of the two pre-series 23 locomotives earlier? The advantages of the locomotive would have been available to the DB as well. The locomotives would have been perfect to haul express trains, as they were particularly fast when accelerating. Our model series 23 002 was operating for the German Federal Railways around 1952 and was very much appreciated by the West German locomotive staff. No wonder that the staff of the locomotive depot didn't miss the chance to mount exquisite boiler bands on the locomotive.
