Electric locomotive class 370 of the Polish State Railways.

- Rich detailing on the model with separately mounted handrails
- Elaborate "roof garden" with four pantographs
- In digital mode available with switchable high beam light and individually switchable headlights or tail lights

Shortly after delivery of the ÖBB locomotives class 1216, the Polish State Railways also ordered ten of the Siemens machines designated by the PKP as 370 series. At the PKP, the locomotives, unlike the ÖBB referred to as "Taurus", are designated "Husarz". The locomotives haul Eurocity trains every day and regularly come to Berlin and Prague.
